Registration of a trade name shall be for a term of ten years counted from the date of registration or deposit and may be renewed for successive ten-year periods.</p> <p>Geographical Indications A geographical indication registration is valid for ten years and may be renewed every ten years.</p> <p>Patent of Invention A patent registration is valid for 20 years only.</p> <p>Utility Models A patent of utility models is valid for 10 year only</p>
