Visa Information

Delegates from some countries will require a visa to enter Denmark. Please check that you meet all visa requirements to enter Denmark and remember to apply for your visa <u>as soon as possible</u>. **Please remember that recently visa approval timescales have been very long and some people have not been able to travel.**

Book your accommodation by using the hotel online link on the Registration Form/Programme. We have a limited number of rooms available in our block allocation. We strongly urge you to make your reservation as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. After 1st September all unreserved rooms will be removed from the Block Booking.

Late arrival Thursday 28th September and dinner

With an early Friday morning start Delegates and APs are strongly recommended to arrive at the hotel on **Thursday evening 28th September**. There is no official Thursday evening dinner. The restaurant at the hotel opens at 6pm and closes at 9pm. If you wish to have dinner at the hotel **you must book your table directly with the hotel to avoid disappointment.** The hotel offers fruit & late snacks. If you wish a sandwich/snacks after 9pm, you can pre-order food at phone: +45 7641 1717 press 3. Also, Vejle, with restaurants and bars is a 20 minute taxi ride from hotel.

Method and location of arrival

The closest airport to the conference is **Billund Airport** (Denmark second largest airport) with direct flights to most of the biggest European hubs.



Transport from Billund Airport (BLL) to Comwell Kellers Park

The fastest way from Billund Airport to the hotel is by taxi (approx. 40 min drive). Taxis from the companies Vejle Taxa (+45 70201222) and Dantaxi (+ 45 48484848) are available just in front of the entrance of Billund Airport https://www.bll.dk/en/

Approximate cost one way from Billund Airport to hotel: Vejle Taxa DKK 710 (EUR 95) and Dantaxi DKK 745 (EUR 100).

Transport from Copenhagen Airport to Vejle and Comwell Kellers Park

The train goes directly from Copenhagen Airport to Vejle Train Station (2,5 hours). The train is operated by DSB - https://www.dsb.dk/en/

From Vejle Station you can grab a taxi to the hotel (approximate 20 min and around DKK 300/EUR 40).

Travel by car

Vejle is situated 1 hour drive from the German border and can easily be reached by the main highway E45 that runs north through Denmark. To get to the hotel use Exit 61A.

Currency and Exchange

The currency in Denmark is Danish Kroner (DKK – Danish Crowns). 1 EUR is approximate 7,45 DKK

All major credit cards are accepted in most hotels, shops, taxis and restaurants. There is an ATM at the airport and in Veile, but not at the hotel.

Climate

The temperature in Denmark in September is at daytime around 15 degrees and at night around 10 degrees. Sometimes we have rain showers and hot weather in September so be prepared for all kinds of weather. Check the weather forecast before you pack at

Danish Sales tax of 25% is included in all prices quoted in shops and restaurants.

Tipping and Service Charge

Tipping is optional in Denmark and only used if the service is good (then approx. 10 % of the bill). Some restaurants will automatically add service, so check your bill.

Electric Current
